Benjamin Andrew Wincott is now subject of an **Anti-Social Behaviour Order (ASBO)**, which lasts until 26th January 2012

Benjamin Andrew Wincott is prohibited from:

1. Being abusive or threatening towards any person engaged in a lawful activity in the county of Nottinghamshire.
2. Playing music so that it is audible outside his boat and causing a nuisance to those in the vicinity of his boat within the county of Nottinghamshire.
3. Being in possession of an open container of alcohol in any public space or building within the county of Nottinghamshire except on premises licensed for the sale and consumption of alcohol and on board his own boat.
4. Mooring any boat on the stretch of canal between Carrington Street and Castle Bridge Road.
5. Entering Sainsbury's at Castle Marina Retail Park at any time. For the avoidance of doubt this includes the store as well as the surrounding car park and petrol station.

Breach of an ASBO is a criminal offence

If Benjamin Andrew Wincott breaks any of these conditions, he risks arrest and being put back before the Courts (which may result in a prison sentence). If you see Benjamin Andrew Wincott breaking the terms of his ASBO, please contact:
